



The TOP TEN most frequently stolen vehicles in Sacramento County in the first quarter of 2006:

A Scion XB Chop Shop discovered in North Highlands. SACCATS personnel developed information of a possible chop shop at 4945 Shell St., North Highlands. On February 8, 2006, a probation search was conducted on Veamin Tveretinov at 4945 Shell St. Tveretinov's 2004 Scion XB was located in his garage however, it contained stolen components belonging to a 2005 Scion XB. Component parts belonging to a second stolen Scion XB were also located in the garage. A 2005 Scion was located parked in the driveway of the residence and the owner; Damyan Leontiy was also located sleeping in the vehicle. Stolen components belonging to a third stolen Scion were located attached to Leontiy's vehicle. Both suspects were arrested for vehicle theft and chop shop charges. Two other subjects; Victor Tveretinov and Aleksandr Lisyuk were also arrested for outstanding warrants. **A lead received from**

www.saccats.org leads to the arrest of 17 subjects, recovery of 30 car stereos and the recovery of 12 stolen vehicles. SACCATS personnel received a tip generated from the SACCATS web site, regarding a stolen Jeep Cherokee. The information led SACCATS investigators to the identification of several target areas in the Citrus Heights and North Highlands area. During the months of February and March, surveillance's were established at the identified target areas. **On February 9, 2006,** Joseph Holquin was arrested driving a stolen 2005 Nissan Frontier. Sabrina Escarraga; who was wanted by SACCATS personnel for another auto theft case was also arrested. Four other suspects were identified as a result of this arrest; Anthony Barton, John Abrusci,

nel located an occupied stolen 1990 Acura in Citrus Heights. Citrus Heights PD units attempted a vehicle stop and Jeffrey Stanfill was apprehended after a vehicle and foot pursuit.

On March 24, 2006, during surveillance of a target area, SACCATS officers observed Andrey Glushko and Aleksey Prokopenko drive up in a stolen 1996 Nissan Altima, park next to an unmarked SACCATS vehicle and switched seating positions. They were later taken into custody with the assistance of Citrus Heights PD. **On March 15, 2006,** during surveillance of a target area, SACCATS personnel observed John Pontes, leave an apartment complex in North Highlands driving a 1997 Honda that was later determined to be an unreported stolen vehicle. Pontes was later apprehended with the assistance of a Sacramento County Sheriff's Department K-9. Pontes had been accompanied by Adam May who had successfully eluded officers. May was on probation and was living in the apartment complex that Pontes had left. After returning to the apartment complex, a second stolen Honda was located and it was later occupied and driven away by David Hummer. Hummer was arrested and linked to another Honda theft by SACCATS personnel. A probation search of May's apartment netted the recovery

of 30 stolen car stereos and speakers.

May's father, Donald May was also arrested for probation violations. SACCATS personnel later caught up to Adam May and took him into custody for Honda thefts and for the 30 car stereos. May's wife; Tamara May was also arrested on outstanding warrants. **On March 16, 2006,** SACCATS personnel responded to a residence in Auburn after developing information from Pontes. Brett Turner was arrested driving a stolen 1992 Honda and Matthew Fabela, who was a roommate was arrested for parole violations. **On March 21, 2006** Miles Martin was arrested after he was observed driving a stolen Honda in a targeted area. Martin was arrested after leading marked units in a short vehicle pursuit and later foot pursuit. Martin had eluded patrol officers on two separate occasions before he was finally apprehended.
